		I know what graduation deferment means and if I need to defer graduation or not to register an internship.

If the internship is taking place in France, I have checked the expiration date of my carte de sejour. If necessary, I have started the renewal application.  Advice: if on US Federal loans, if you will need to apply for a visa, if you will need to use the internship registration to renew your titre de sejour in France, please start looking for an internship well in advance.
I have discussed the timing of my internship(s) and how it fits with the rest of my course requirements.	Please consider which semester(s) would be the best suited for doing an internship. If you want to intern full-time, you cannot take classes alongside. If you are taking classes, a part-time internship is an option under certain conditions.
