

**DEGREE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE MA IN INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS,
CONFLICT RESOLUTION and CIVIL SOCIETY DEVELOPMENT (MIA)
Fall 2017**

Minimum credit requirement: 62 credits

Minimum Cum GPA: 3.000

The 62 credits must include:

- 8 crs Two core courses
- 12 crs Three elective courses
- 12 crs Six two-credit modules PO5002
- 16 crs Four courses at the Sorbonne
- 2 crs Thesis Seminar PO5099
- 12 crs One twelve-credit research project PO5095

Core courses

(8 credits) two of the following four courses:

PL/PO 5005 Philosophical Foundations of International Relations

PO 5012 Civil Society: International Perspective

PO 5058 Conflict Management (new)

PO 5072 US and World Affairs

PO 5075 Ecole de Guerre

Three electives

(12 credits) chosen from the PO and LW course offerings

Plus

(16 credits) **Four courses at the Sorbonne** (4 crs each)

Plus

PO 5002 Six two-credit Modules (12 credits)

PO 5099 Master Thesis Seminar (2 credits)

PO 5095 Master Thesis Project (12 credits)

Graduate students must maintain a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.00

Students with a GPA of less than 3.00 will be placed on probation.

Only two grades of C (C+ included) may be counted towards an MA degree.
