

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE MA IN INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS (MIN)

ONE YEAR

Fall 2019 and beyond

Minimum credit requirement: 38 credits
Minimum Cum GPA: 3.000

The 38 credits must include:

- 10 crs Five two-credit modules PO5002
- 20 crs Two core and three elective courses
- 2 crs Thesis seminar PO5099
- 6 crs One six-credit thesis project PO5095

Core courses

(8 credits) two of the following four courses:

PL/PO 5005 Philosophical Foundations of International Relations
PO 5012 Civil Society: International Perspective
PO 5058 Conflict Management (new)
PO 5072 US and World Affairs

Three electives

(12 credits) chosen from the PO and LW course offerings

Plus

PO 5002 Five two-credit Modules (10 credits)
PO 5099 Master Thesis Seminar (2 credits)

PO 5095 Master Thesis Project (6 credits)

Graduate students must maintain a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.00
Students with a GPA of less than 3.00 will be placed on probation.
Only two grades of C (C+ included) may be counted towards an MA degree.
