Minimum credit requirement: 40 credits

(8 credits) chosen from the BA course offerings

plus

(8 credits) chosen from the graduate course offerings

Plus

BA 5098 Internship (4 credits)

or

BA 5095 Master Thesis Project (4 credits)

Graduate students must maintain a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.00

Students with a GPA of less than 3.00 will be placed on probation.

Only two grades of C (C+ included) may be counted towards an MA degree.
