

DEGREE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE MSc in International Management (MSIM)

Fall 2019

Minimum credit requirement: 40 credits
Minimum Cum GPA: 3.000

The 40 credits must include:

- 20 crs Seven core courses
- 2 crs Research Methods/Consulting Methods
- 12 crs Twelve Elective Credits
- 6 crs Internship or Thesis

Students with a GPA of less than 3.00 will be placed on probation.
Only two grades of C (C+ included) may be counted towards an MA degree.
