CHARGE TO THE PRESIDENTIAL SEARCH COMMITTEE
By the Board of Trustees

With input from the entire AUP community and our search firm, and drawing upon AUP's mission, vision and strategic plan, prepare a statement for candidates of opportunities and challenges for the University's next president.

With input from the entire AUP community and our search firm, prepare a candidate profile of desired professional experience and personal qualities considered vital to lead AUP to its next level of growth and development for discussion and final approval by the Board of Trustees.

With the help of members of the Board, extend outreach by providing the search firm with a curated list of individuals well placed to identify highly qualified prospective candidates.

Conduct an active, inclusive, global search to attract a diverse pool of highly qualified candidates.

Conduct a well-organized search process that reflects well upon the reputation of the University internally and externally.

Maintain absolute confidentiality concerning the names of candidates and discussions within the Search Committee throughout the search and beyond.

Make periodic reports to the Board and members of the University community about the progress of the search process while maintaining confidentiality about candidates.

Recommend to the Board of Trustees a minimum of three finalist candidates with substantiation of the Committee's conclusions that the candidates meet the criteria originally set forth. Depending on the caliber of candidates, the Committee may present more than three candidates.
