

WHO NEEDS A VISA? WHICH TYPE OF VISA DO YOU NEED TO APPLY FOR?	INFORMATION FROM THE FRENCH CONSULAR AUTHORITIES

### **SHORT STAY STUDENT VISA**

**ONE-SEMESTER STAY**

**ONE-YEAR STAY**

- In order to be issued this visa, you must:
  - BE A NON EU
  - BE 18/ OVER 18
  - BE A FULL-TIME STUDENT
  - BE A VISITING STUDENT FOR 1 SEMESTER or FOR 1 YEAR **WITH NO INTENTION OF EXTENDING YOUR STAY HERE**
- This student visa **CANNOT** be renewed/ extended in France.
- If the students change their plans and wish to remain longer at AUP, they are required to **go back to their residence country in order to do a long stay student visa application** to be issued a long stay student visa to legally return AUP.
- **The Master Students** who study at AUP more than one year since they are expected to remain here to do their thesis or internship **should definitely NOT** be issued this type of visa (which cannot be extended).
- ***This visa cannot be issued to the students who are 18.***



#### **VISA REMARKS**



**UNDER 18 VISA**  
**Visa for Minors**  
**« Visa Mineur scolarisé »**

- This visa is issued to the NON EU students who are still **under 18** by the time they apply for a visa to study in France.
- This visa is issued to the NON EU students who are still **under 18** by the time they enter France and they start studying at AUP.
- **This visa legalizes the minor student stay in France** (under a student status) **until they turn 18**.
- One month before the student turns 18, they must be in touch with SIS to schedule an appointment in order to apply for a residency from their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday.
- If the student holding this type of visa **turns 18 while being temporary out of France/ back home** (for the Fall Break, the Christmas Break, the Spring break, or the Summer break), they are required to apply for a long stay student visa to legally come back to France after celebrating their 18<sup>th</sup> anniversary back home.

**SIS ADVICE:** Please contact the French Consular Authorities of your residence country for some additional information and to make sure you are issued the correct visa.


